Andrea Bobotis (pronounced with two long o's) is the author of the debut novel *The Last List of Miss Judith Kratt*, forthcoming from Sourcebooks on July 9, 2019. A native of South Carolina, she holds a Ph.D. in English literature from the University of Virginia. Her fiction has received runner-up awards from the Raymond Carver Short Story Contest and the James Jones First Novel Fellowship, and her essays on Irish writers have appeared in academic journals such as *Victorian Studies* and the *Irish University Review*. She lives with her family in Denver, Colorado, where she teaches creative writing to youth at Lighthouse Writers Workshop. She also teaches yoga and is a national parks geek.

Andrea Bobotis's atmospheric debut novel, *The Last List of Miss Judith Kratt*, follows a spinster sister as she untangles the dark legacy of her family's possessions in a South Carolina cotton town.
